8. Describe the location for the facility to include:
  - a. Address, name of building or principal occupant.
  - b. A copy of the lease or site agreement.
  - c. Blueprint draft showing the location of the square footage allocated to the proposed teletheater.
  - d. Blueprint draft demonstrating the floor plan to be utilized within the teletheater.
9. Written confirmation from appropriate local officials indicating that the location of the proposed facility and the number of patrons expected to occupy such facility are in compliance with all applicable ordinances and codes, i.e. compliance with zoning ordinances and compliance with fire code.
10. Financial statement of the applicant including, but not limited to, the following:
  - a. Balance sheet thru the quarters:
    - ended June 30 of the current year
    - ended June 30 of the previous year
    - ended June 30 of two (2) years previous
  - b. Income and expense statements thru the quarter ended June 30 of the current year and for the year ended previous December 31.
11. Statements of support or non-support from the local jurisdictional governing body.
12. A statement of the applicant's history and experience in gaming and wagering activities. This statement must include any rulings, fines, penalties, or investigations in regard to the applicant or associates of the applicant.





# Applicants for Simulcast Operator's License

## Definition:

A Simulcast Operator is an eligible organization licensed by the North Dakota Racing Commission to offer, sell, cash, redeem, or exchange pari-mutuel tickets on races being simulcast from a sending track.

An eligible organization is an organization eligible to conduct off-track wagering pursuant to North Dakota Century Code, Section 53.06.2-06.

## NDCC 53-06.2-06

Organizations eligible to conduct racing: Civic and service clubs, charitable, fraternal, religious, and veterans' organizations, and other public spirited organizations may be licensed to conduct racing as authorized by this chapter.

## Instructions:

Any eligible organization may apply to the North Dakota Racing Commission for a license to conduct off-track wagering as a Simulcast operator pursuant to the laws of the State of North Dakota and the Administrative Rules of the North Dakota Racing Commission.

Each applicant shall submit to the office of the North Dakota Racing Commission, a narrative with supporting documentation in response to the attached 19 items of inquiry.
